- *SNO is a collaborative network of the 14 Lead Agencies who represent 14 regions across Ontario
- *Each Lead Agency is responsible to deliver and oversee Student Nutrition Programs across the Province
- *In 2019/2020 we served 97,000,000 meals
- *During COVID we served close to 16,000,000 meals to at home learners
- *We have 4,586 programs across the province
